Enjoy lunch while being entertained by songs, stories, and writing insight from one of Nashville's most accomplished songwriters.



Later this afternoon you will be able to enjoy a tour of the Ryman Auditorium, which was home to the Grand Ole Opry for more than 30 years. You also will have time to take in the Johnny Cash Museum. You will be able to enjoy memories and artifacts from the singer's impressive career,

including performance highlights and television cameos. Later we will be checking into the famous Opryland Hotel Resort, which we will be calling home for the next two evenings. This evening's show is an exciting celebration of the songs that made Music City. *Opry Country Classics* features a celebrity host sharing great stories and songs, guests singing their own hits as well as timeless favorites by the likes of *Patsy Cline* and *Johnny Cash*, and a Spotlight Artist headlining the show with several of his or her memorable classics at the Ryman Auditorium.
